Applicant Eligibility

- Students must currently be enrolled in high school or college courses (including public, private, parochial and home school) and be between the ages of 14 - 19
- Students should have a serious interest in music and a desire to broaden their musical knowledge and appreciation
- Students should have fundamental composition, songwriting and performance skills
- Students should be passionate about pursuing a career in music
- Students should demonstrate a visionary spirit and be willing to take on a leadership role within the group

Participant Requirements

Students will be required to:

- Attend the entire week-long program
- Attend required performances throughout the duration of the program
- Be active participants in the program, helping to contribute to its success
- Act as student ambassadors for the GRAMMY Museum and the program

Application Materials

To apply, students must submit:

- A completed application form, including parent or guardian signature
- A one-page personal statement, describing how music plays a role in their life and, if chosen, what they would like to gain from this experience
- A short audio or video clip of a performance (singing, playing an instrument, DJ'ing, producing, etc)
